

Copper Creek Farm

At the foot of the Appalachian Mountains, Copper Creek is a place where families, school groups and businesses can have fun and make memories worth repeating. The farm is home to two annual events: Sunflower Festival during the summer and Corn Maze & Pumpkin Fest during the fall. Stop by the general store for glazed pecans, peanut brittle, goat soap, local honey and t-shirts.



New Echota State Historic Site – Cherokee Capital 1211 Chatsworth Highway

New Echota, once the capital of the Cherokee Nation, is one of the most significant Cherokee Indian sites in the nation. Here was the official beginning of the infamous "Trail of Tears" as well as the home of the first Indian language newspaper. Tour 12 original and reconstructed buildings, view interpretive exhibits and a 17-minute film. Open Tue.-Sat., 9 a.m.-5 p.m., Sun. 1 p.m.-5 p.m. December-March, closed on Sundays. Admission charged.

Battle of Resaca Reenactment Third weekend in May

Chitwood Road Resaca, (706) 625-3200

The first major battle of the Atlanta Campaign was fought around the tiny village of Resaca on May 14-15, 1864. Over two days, Union and Confederate forces attacked and counterattacked, with both armies losing approximately 2,800 men. The reenactment is held on the historic Chitwood Farm, a 650-acre section of the original battlefield. Evident within the property are the original Federal and Confederate entrenchments and the 1864 Western & Atlantic Railroad line. Admission charged.

Fort Wayne Civil War Historic Site

Fort Wayne's two well-preserved fortified areas were used by both Confederate and Union forces during and after the Civil War. Walk the one-mile trail to view the original parade grounds and entrenchments which are the last known constructed by the Georgia Militia. Open daily dawn-dusk. Free admission.






Resaca Battlefield Historic Site 183 Resaca Lafayette Road Resaca, (706) 602-4435 GordonCountyParks.org Six miles of trails will take you where much of the heaviest fighting occurred during the first major battle of the "Atlanta Campaign" of the Civil War. The park includes massive earthen Confederate and Federal infantry and artillery fortifications, interpretive signage and a covered picnic pavilion. Open Fri.-Sun., dawn to dusk. Free admission.

Resaca Confederate Cemetery

Confederate Cemetery Road Resaca, (706) 625-3200

As the first Confederate Cemetery to be dedicated in the nation, it is the final resting place of more than 450 solders who died in the Battle of Resaca. During the war, Col. John F. Green and his family fled their home in Resaca. They returned to find dead Confederate soldiers still lying on the battlefield area.



Upset by the sight, Col. Green's daughters, Mary and Pyatt, decided to collect the bodies and give them proper burials. Their father gave them 2.5 acres of land to use as a cemetery. Mary Green started the cemetery in July 1866 without any money. The cemetery was dedicated at the end of October, and all debts were paid by the end of December 1866. Open daily dawn to dusk. Free admission.

Atlanta Campaign Pavilion 3949 U.S. Highway 41 N. Resaca

The Works Progress Administration built this third in a series of five parks in the 1930s, identifying sites of the Civil War's Atlanta Campaign. The pavilion features a relief map of troop movements and fighting in and around Resaca May 13-15, 1864. It is on the northern section of the battlefield. The map explains the events at the Battle of Resaca and the Federal flanking movement at Lay's Ferry, which resulted in Johnston's withdrawal south over the Oostanaula River along the Western and Atlantic Railroad to Calhoun and then Cassville.

Born in Gordon County, Roland Hayes was a child of former slaves who became the first African American vocalist to achieve international acclaim. Learn the details of his remarkable half-century career as a renowned tenor through photos, stories, records, autographed programs, personal letters and music scores. Hours: Mon. 10 a.m.- 2 p.m., Tues.-Thurs. 10 a.m.- 4 p.m., Fridays 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Free admission.
